

REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES:

1. A Life Group Childcare Reimbursement Request must be submitted within fourteen (14) days after attending the Life Group meeting to qualify for reimbursement.

2. Reimbursements are made at a set hourly rate for the cost of an individual childcare provider in your home while you attend a small group away from your home. See the paragraph at the bottom of this page for rates.

3. Complete one (1) Life Group Childcare Request Form for each Life Group meeting attended. Please use original form—copies are not accepted.
